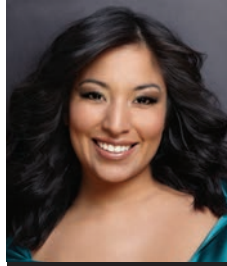

Veneers

Veneers are thin "shells" or facings that are designed to enhance the front of your teeth. Typically, these are designed by a trained dental lab technician using a ceramic tooth-colored material. Veneers are a strong, permanent choice to close gaps, correct chipped teeth or brighten discolored teeth that have not responded to bleaching in the past.

Direct Bonding

Direct bonding can repair small chips, cracks and minimal gaps between teeth. This procedure can be performed here in our office using a tooth-colored filling material that is shaped onto your natural tooth structure and sculpted to mimic your natural tooth structure. The material is then hardened into place using a high-powered light source.

Teeth Whitening

Certainly one of the most popular cosmetic procedures available, teeth whitening or teeth bleaching, is now available in a variety of delivery methods.
